Storm Water Pollution Plan (SWPPP) is required for all construction activity resulting in a land disturbance of one acre or more, or less than one acre but part of a larger common plan of development or sale. Construction activity includes clearing, grading, excavation, stockpiling, and reconstruction of existing facilities involving removal and replacement. Construction activity does not include routine maintenance such as, maintenance of original line and grade, hydraulic capacity, or original purpose of the facility.

Effective July 1, 2010 all dischargers are required to obtain coverage under the Construction General Permit Order 2009-0009-DWQ adopted on September 2, 2009.
